Chapter 335-6-11 (Use Classifications for Surface Waters)

Summary of Reasons Supporting the Adoption of Proposed Revisions

Revisions to rule 335-6-11-.02 are being proposed to revise the water use classifications for the Black Warrior River Basin segments of Duck River (3 segments) in Cullman County. The specific revisions are listed below:

335-6-11-.02(2) The Black Warrior River Basin

- **Duck River** (from Mulberry Fork to Duck Lake Dam): This change is proposed to (1) add a segment not previously identified by name, and (2) classify the segment "Fish and Wildlife."
- **Duck River (Duck Lake)** (from Duck Lake Dam to the extent of reservoir): This change is proposed to (1) add a segment not previously identified by name, and (2) classify the segment "Public Water Supply" and "Fish and Wildlife" to reflect its use as a water supply source by the Utilities Board of the City of Cullman.
- **Duck River** (from Duck Lake to its source): This change is proposed to (1) add a segment not previously identified by name, and (2) classify the segment "Fish and Wildlife."
